## Status Quo (Large vs Small)

#### Large scale solar project:

- Identification of two sites (Adam & Manah)
- Data gathered and published since 2011
- Recent policy guidance provided by Government
- Currently evaluating advisors to assist with tendering process and establishing benchmark price



## Status Quo (Large vs Small)

#### Small scale project:

- Rooftop Solar project lead by the Authority
  - Draft technical regulations under review
  - Agency Contract within the current statutory framework
  - Potential incentives to be linked to Bulk Supply Tariff
- Rural Area Projects
  - Electrification policy approved by Authority where
     PIAD must be submitted considering renewable energy



## Way Forward (Large vs Small)

#### **Large Scale**

- Release of competition documents mid 2017 conditional on positive assessment of benchmark price
- Competition process similar to I(W)PP with 100% foreign ownership

#### **Small Scale**

- Consultation on draft regulations and incentive mechanism for roof-top PV (January 2017)
- Two small scale rural projects to be tendered in Q1 2017 (AL Khadra 2.2 MW, Al Mazyunah 2.8 MW)
- RAEC completed a business plan (2017-2021) with ten sites (potential aggregate capacity of around 26 MW) have been selected for implementation of renewable energy projects.



### **Potential Barriers**

- Discrepancy in fuel cost, financial vs. economic
- Subsidised customer tariffs disincentivise deployment
- Absence of an overall energy policy with renewable quota
- Availability of local financing for small-scale projects



## Role of the Regulator

- Minimise regulatory burden for deployment of renewable energy
- Publish data to shift towards economic fuel price
- In the absence of a clear policy, utilise current regulatory framework to facilitate deployment
- Ensure fair and transparent competition for projects
- Establish framework for implementing a programme and not just projects
